



# Sexual Lives & Respectful Relationships (SL&RR): Peer Educators

**Peer Educators are people who identify as peers of, or the same as, people with intellectual disability. They stand up for everyone's relationship rights.**

## *How do I become a Peer Educator?*

Peer Educators might have experience in advocacy, training, group work, or may have personal interest in sexuality and relationship rights. You will complete four days of training with Program Partners from your local SL&RR site. This training is run by Deakin University.

## *What do Peer Educators do?*

- Introduce and run the SL&RR program alongside Program Partners
- Introduce and discuss the SL&RR stories
- Be a role model about positive attitudes and values about sexuality and relationship rights
- Make sure that everyone gets a chance to have their say
