



# Sexual Lives & Respectful Relationships (SL&RR): Stories

The SL&RR program is based on real-life stories told by people with intellectual disability, talking about sex and relationships in their lives.

**Molly:** "My dream is to get married, walk down the aisle with my dad you know. Have a honeymoon somewhere, get a house and raise a couple of kids. But with my parents, 'Molly can't do this, she won't get married?'"

**Hannah:** "It's hard to get privacy. Sometimes we go into the city for the night but we can't afford to stay away for the night. We walk around and then we got to Pizza Hut in Russell Street. Some of the staff there are friends of ours and we know the security guard very well. He lets us stay there."

**Kevin:** "We asked her brother about moving out. He doesn't want us to live in a house. He wants her to live in special accommodation all her life. So I'll spend my life with her there."

Key messages have been drawn from these stories and are used to focus discussion in the workshops about rights and respect in relationships.

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
